CONDITIONS

1. Entry Fees must be paid at time of entry.
2. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Match Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final.
3. In every event, competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Match Committee may arrange, and the Match Committee, or such person as they may authorise, shall have the power to select a marker for any competitor whose fellow competitor is not at the first the when called upon at the time appointed to start.
4. The Match Committee to make all arrangements, and to have full power to alter or make any variation in the Conditions of the Program should they deem it desirable.
5. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, shorten the contest, or fix another day.
6. (i) In the event of a tie, in the Individual Event, the winner will be decided on a countback over the last 9, 6, 3, holes. If still tied, then hole by hole from the 18th. (ii) In the event of a tie, in the Teams Event, the winning team will be decided by countback, combining the three team members' scores over the last 9, 6, 3 holes. If still tied, then hole by hole from the 18th.
7. The events are open to all players of Clubs registered with the Womens' Golf Victoria.
8. The Match Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries which will be received in any event, and to alter the time fixed for starting any event as indicated in this program.
9. The attention of all entrants is drawn to the necessity of complete accuracy in her entry form and any entrant who is misrepresented renders herself liable to disqualification.
10. Trophy details: Each member of the winning team will receive a trophy and the name of the winning Club will be engraved on the Cup. If any member of the original team is unable to play, a substitute player may be arranged from the same Club. Trophies will also be awarded for the best individual scores in 3 Divisions - only one major prize per player.
