# Ballarat Golf Club Junior Scholarship Program Selection Process

The Ballarat Golf Club Junior Scholarship Program is designed to accelerate the development of young golfers by providing them with the resources, guidance, and opportunities to gain skills and confidence both on and off the course.

The scholarship will be awarded to those individuals who the selection panel believe will achieve the greatest personal growth, rather than just golfing development, leading to an overall and positive life-changing experience.

Each application will be assessed based on this, including the following points:

## 1. Passion for Golf

- Demonstrates a strong enthusiasm for the sport.
- Actively participates in golf-related activities, training or competitions.

## 2. Commitment to Development

- Shows dedication to improving skills through practice and coaching.
- Willingness to engage in training sessions and mentorship opportunities.

## 3. Sportsmanship and Character

- Displays respect, integrity and good sportsmanship on and off the course.
- Ability to work well with peers, coaches and Club members.

## 4. Community Engagement

- Involvement in local golf events or initiatives.
- Willingness to represent the Ballarat Golf Club positively.

## 5. Opportunity

- Recognises and communicates how the Scholarship provides opportunity for ongoing personal growth beyond the golf experience.

## 6. Eligibility Requirements

- Must be under 18 years of age as of June 30th, 2026.
- Resides within the Ballarat District Golf Association Region.

## 7. Selection Panel

- The Scholarship recipients will be chosen by a panel including a PGA Professional, the General Manager of the Ballarat Golf Club, and the Member Service Manager, who will assess each application based on the above.
